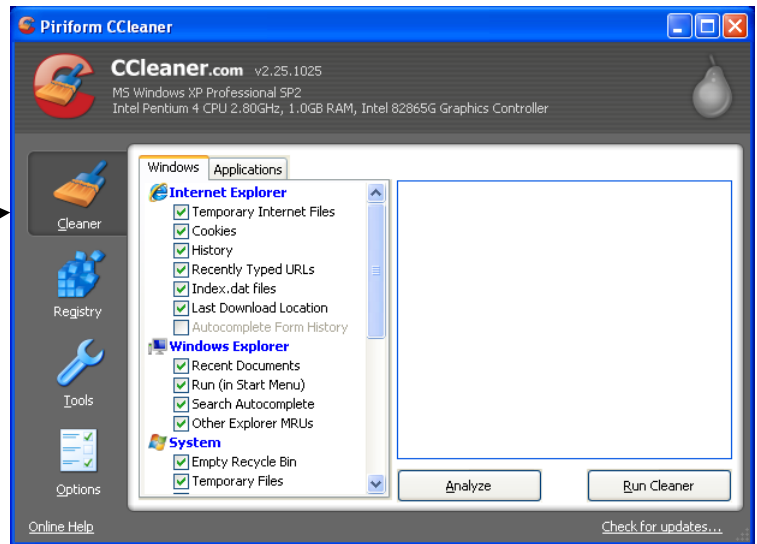
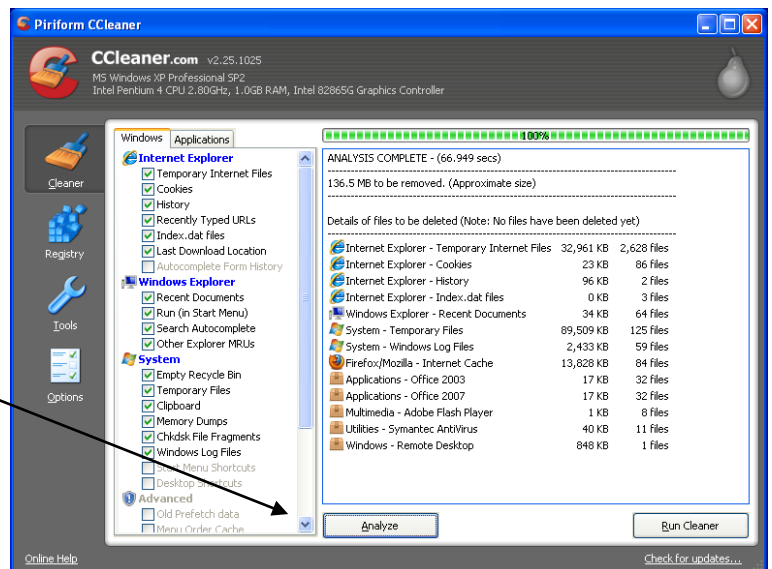


Instructions for CCleaner

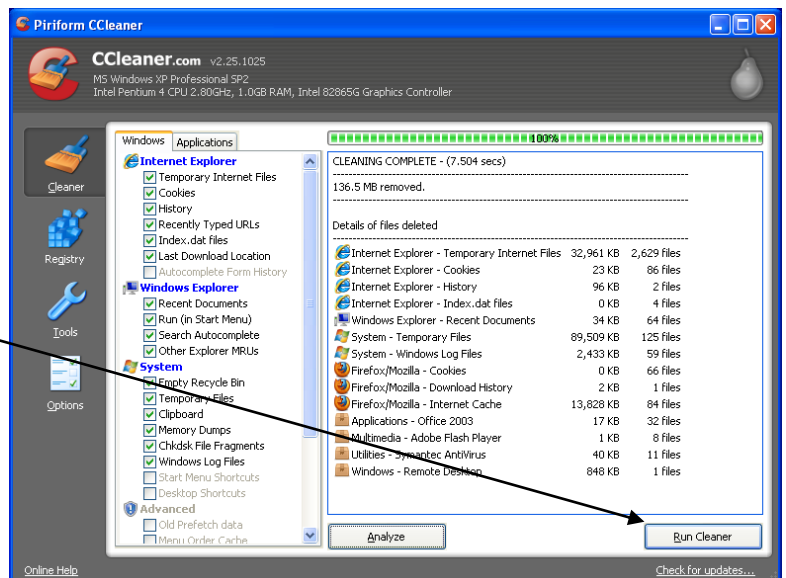
CCleaner is a very useful program that performs several functions. Once you have downloaded, installed and run it, this is the first screen you will see. The first function listed is *Cleaner*



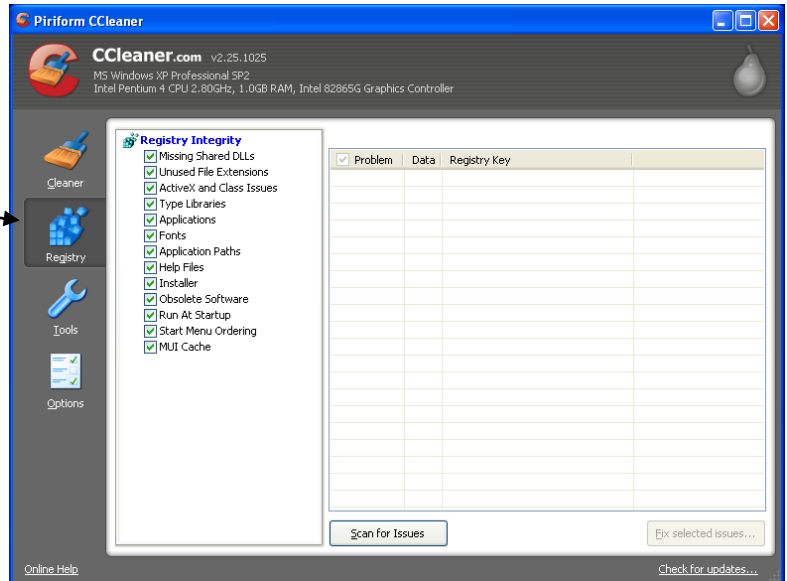
Click on *Analyze* and a list of files to be removed will appear



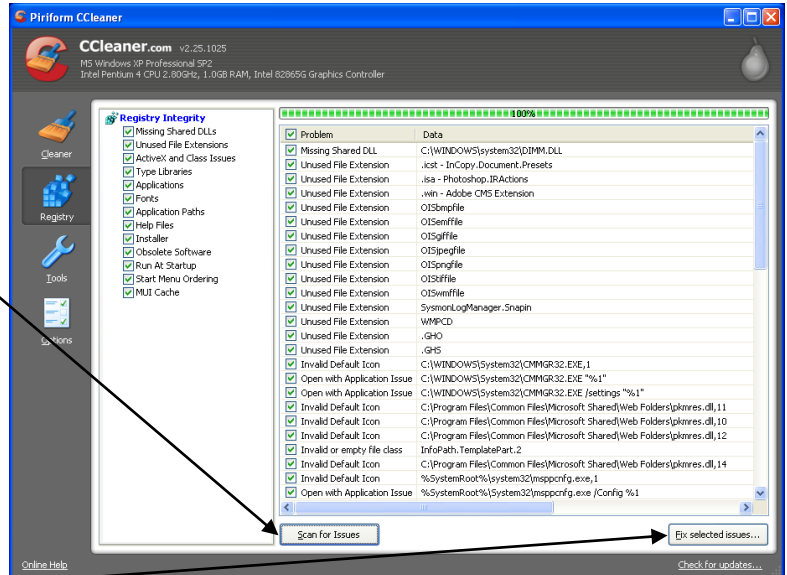
Then click on *Run Cleaner* and all those unnecessary files will be removed



The next step is to click on *Registry* and you will see this screen

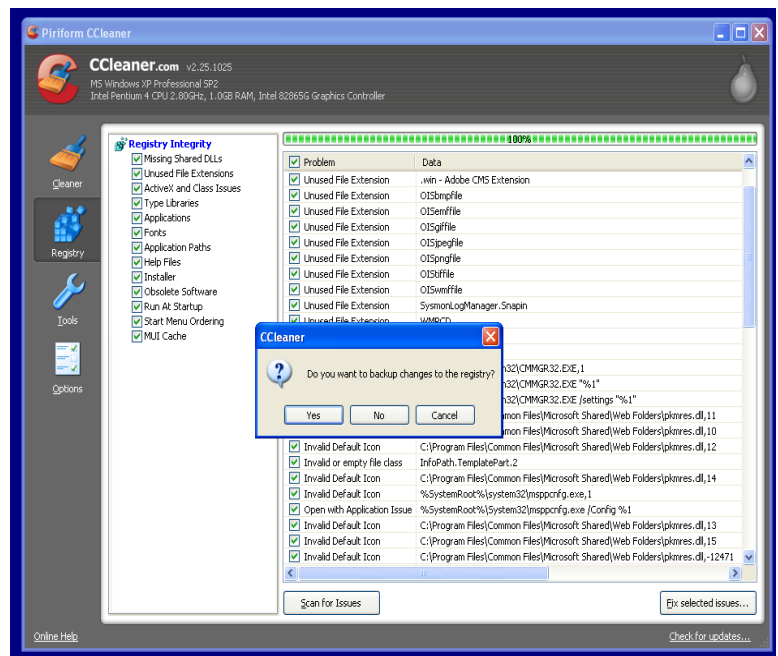


Next you *Scan for Issues*

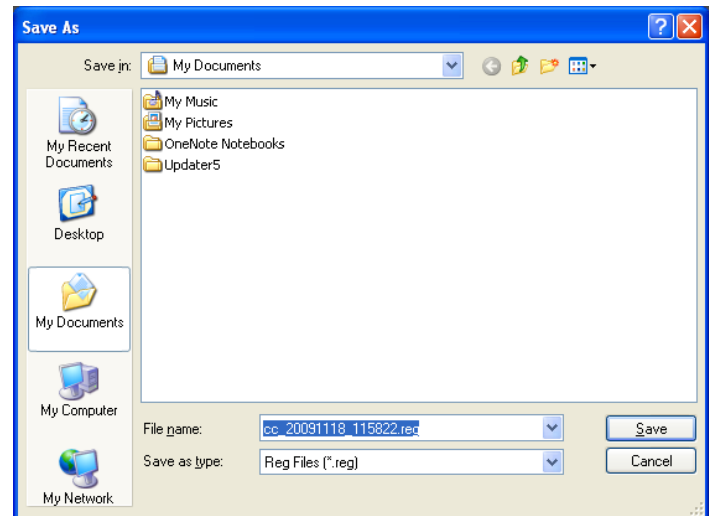


There are lots of issues on this computer, so we want to fix them!

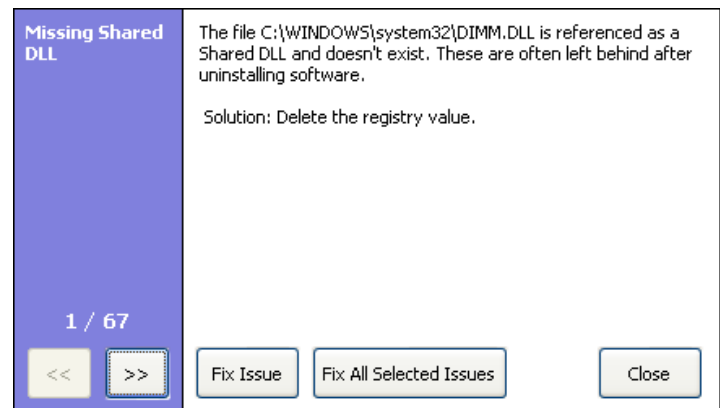
You will be asked whether you want to *'backup changes to the registry'*. This means that a copy of your original registry can be saved. That way, if deleting a file extension has caused a problem for some reason, your original registry can be restored. Select Yes.



You will be asked where to put the backup file, so choose somewhere you can find it again easily.



You have the choice of going through the issues one by one and deciding whether to fix each one, or just choosing to fix all selected issues.



You're done and hopefully your computer will thank you for it, by running more smoothly!
